

De Porres Club

Opens New Center

The new De Porres center at 1918 N. 24th street opened officially on Sunday, October 2, with an open house. Leo Bohanan, executive secretary of the Urban League, and the Rev. John P. Markoe, S.J., moderator of the De Porres club, spoke during the short program.

Dennis Holland, president of the club, urged that everyone use the free facilities of the center. These include a circulating library, clothing and shoes to be given away, and literature on Negro-white relations. The center will be open to all from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

When the De Porres club found it necessary to move after conducting the center at 1914 N. 24th street for one year, the new location was re-plastered and decorated.
