IPH and Women's Basketball Host Food Drive

As part of a season-long partnership, Creighton's women's basketball team and the Institute for Population Health (IPH) are supporting the Food Bank for the Heartland by hosting a food drive during the team's final regular season game, Sunday, March 2, against Villanova. Tipoff is at 7:30 p.m. CT.

"We are happy to partner with Coach Jim Flanery and the women's basketball team with a focus on raising awareness and working to address food insecurity in our community," said Scott Shipman, MD, MPH, executive director for the IPH. "The food drive is one important element of the team's commitment, and we ask Creighton fans to support fellow community members who may need some assistance. More than 1 in 3 people in northeast and southeast Omaha struggle to access sufficient food, and 1 out of 5 children throughout Nebraska experiences food insecurity."

"The team and coaches are committed to helping our neighbors who may be experiencing food insecurity," said Jim Flanery, head coach. "No one should have to go hungry."

In addition to the food drive, the team and IPH have partnered on a season-long contest tied to 3-pointers, with proceeds going to benefit community organizations. The team will also contribute volunteer hours in the offseason to work with a nonprofit that addresses food insecurity in Omaha.

For the food drive, partners at the Creighton Bookstore have generously provided a coupon for a 10% discount to all who participate.

Those attending these games are encouraged to bring the following most-needed items: canned tuna/chicken, canned fruits and vegetables, canned and dry beans, pork and beans, pasta and sauce, boxed meals, pancake mix, peanut butter, rice, cereal, and macaroni and cheese.

This first is the public forum, “The Future of Open Inquiry Online and on Campus,” on Thursday, Feb. 27, at 5 p.m. in the Harper Center, Hixon Lied Auditorium. This thought-provoking panel will explore how to foster a culture of open inquiry in an age of polarization and misinformation.

Panelists include Scott Atlas, of Stanford University, author Renée DiResta, and Dr. John Tomasi, of Brown University. Moderated by Richard C. Mangrum, PhD, professor at Creighton University, the discussion promises deep insights into the challenges and importance of meaningful dialogue in the pursuit of truth and justice. The second is a Food for Thought public lecture, "Freedom and Flourishing," on Thursday, March 6, at 4 p.m. in the Harper Center, Room 3048.

that one need not think of a culture that results from a political/legal order that makes the protection of liberty paramount but does not directly point its citizens towards the good as offering ethically what is only second best (or even worse). The article, co-authored with Eric Hansen, PhD, BA'12, and Elise Blasingame, explores Native American Legislators' ability to pass Native focused legislation in state legislatures. Research for the project was completed as part of Witmer's political science research lab, with the assistance of Creighton undergraduate researchers.
