Instructions for proper procedures in reporting of workers' compensation claims are located at [www.creighton.edu/risk](http://www.creighton.edu/risk). Remember that the Creighton University Injury and Illness Report (Form 24) should be completed and forwarded to the Risk Management office by the injured employee or their supervisor within 24 hours of the incident. Failure to promptly report an injury or illness may result in delays in payment of medical bills and authorization for treatment. Question workers' compensation claims should be directed to the Risk Management office at x2612.
