NEW GRADUATE DEAN: Fr. Morrison announces that Professor of Nursing Dr. Barbara Braden has been appointed dean of the Graduate School. Dr. Braden will succeed Dr. Michael Lawler as Graduate School dean on July 1. Dr. Braden received her bachelor's degree from Creighton in 1975. She earned a master's degree in nursing from the University of California at San Francisco in 1975 and her doctorate from the University of Texas at Austin in 1988. Dr. Braden joined the Creighton faculty in 1974 and in 1990 was appointed professor of nursing. She has received international recognition for her research, which includes the development of the Braden Scale for Predicting Pressure Sore Risk, and her teaching has been recognized with

the "Teacher of the Year" award in the School of Nursing and two nominations for the Robert F. Kennedy Outstanding Teacher Award.

VISITORS' LOT CLOSED: Required work to rearrange and renovate the current visitors' parking lot as a part of the Lied Education Center for the Arts project will begin on Monday, May 15. Construction will require complete closure of the lot for one week while Kiewit completes work at the entrance/exit point. Parking slots along the western edge will be available for Jesuit parking on May 22. The remaining lot will be closed through June 16. Visitors' parking will be available in a designated row at the south of the ball field parking lot. Signs will be posted from the current visitors' lot leading visitors to the temporary lot.
