

Simulator Checklist for MD 137

Chester Chest Simulator

Note: Make sure all the following items listed below are in the carrying case/container before re-shelving the simulator

- **1 Chest model attached to white board with attached PICC line (white tubes)**
- **1 Attachable Arm**
- **1 Outer Tissue Flap #405 (should already be attached to the model)**
- **3 Difficult Accessing Insert Pads (#420, #430, & #440)**
- **Set of 2 bolts to attach arm to main body**
- **2 Simulated Blood Reservoir Bags**
- **1 Bottle of Baby Powder**

The Following Items Should Be Inside White Envelope

- **1 Three Page VATA “Helpful Hints” Manual**
- **1 “Avoid Damage to Simulator” insert**
- **1 “Medical Definitions for MD 137” list**
