NOW ON THIS 17 day of August, 2001, this matter came on before the Nebraska Tax Equalization and Review Commission on Appellee's Offer to Confess Judgment. The attorney for the Appellee produces and exhibits and files herein his Warrant of Attorney and Offer to Confess Judgment, duly executed and acknowledged, showing Appellee authorizes its attorney to confess judgment in the action herein, to-wit: for the tax year 2000 and as of January 1, 2000 the actual value of the lands as described in exhibit "A" be set in the amount Five Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-four Dollars (\$562,964.00).

The Commission finds that said Warrant of Attorney and Appellee's Offer to Confess Judgment are in due form and that Appellant has duly assented in writing to the entry of judgment in its favor.

The Commission further finds that the Offer to Confess Judgment should be approved by the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that for the tax year 2000 and as of January 1, 2000 the actual value of the lands as described in exhibit "A" be set in the amount of Five Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-four Dollars (\$562,964.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this decree and judgment be certified to the County Assessor of Hall County, Nebraska, who shall correct the assessment books in her office accordingly; and that this decree and judgment be certified to the County Treasurer of Hall County, Nebraska, and if any taxes have been paid that are affected by this decision, said treasurer shall distribute or return the same in accordance with this decision and the treasurer shall correct her records to conform to this decision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party shall pay their own costs incurred herein.
