**RECYCLING UPDATE:** The enormous response to the campus recycling program has created hardships for our recycling bin manufacturers! While some bins will have been cast, shipped and distributed on campus by this Friday, others will not be shipped and distributed until a later date. But keep up the excitement — the bins are coming soon.

**LABORATORY SAFETY REMINDER:** All commercial and secondary chemical containers (containers into which chemicals are transferred) must be labeled in accordance with Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards. This includes: date of receipt/transfer, chemical name and basic hazard warnings. Chemical symbols alone are not satisfactory. Secondary containers must be at least equal to the original container in their ability to safely store the chemical. Unlabeled chemicals cause accidents and injury in labs. In addition, failure to properly label chemical containers in accordance with 29CFR1910.1200 (HAZCOM) and 29CFR1910.1450 (Laboratory Safety Standard) can result in OSHA fines in excess of \$7,000.
