Creighton University's Health Sciences Library/Learning Resources Center has purchased a site-license for RefWorks, the web-based bibliographic and database management tool. RefWorks allows users to create a personal database online and format citations into a wide variety of bibliographic citation styles. Training sessions will be held in the HSL/LRC's computer lab on Tuesday, June 28, from noon-1:30 p.m. and again from 3-4:30 p.m. Sessions will consist of one hour instruction followed by a questions and/or hands-on period for RefWorks. ### Dr. Claude Organ Passes Away

Claude Harold Organ Jr., MD'52, passed away June 18. Dr. Organ was a former professor and chair of the Department of Surgery at Creighton. He joined the faculty in 1960 and served as chair from 1971 to 1982. He most recently was an *emeritus* professor in the Department of Surgery at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) and served as chief of the UCSF East Bay Surgery Residency Program. He is a past president of the American College of Surgeons (ACS) and received the organization's highest honor — the Distinguished Service Award — in 1999.
