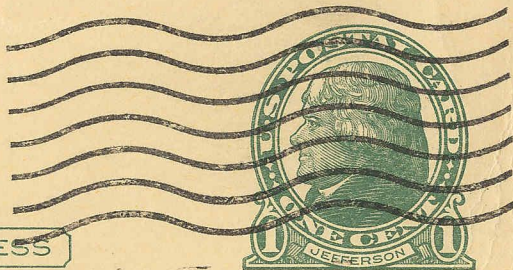
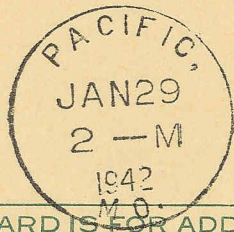


Jan. 29, 1942.
