Creighton Enhances Tuition Remission Policy

Effective Tuesday, Aug. 15, Creighton University will be expanding its tuition benefit offerings for employees, their spouses and their dependent children following a multistage, campuswide feedback process.

Tuition remission, which covers the credit-hour costs for eligible groups who wish to take Creighton University courses, was identified as one of the University's most preferred rewards based on data collected through the Total Rewards Survey conducted in fall 2023. Following additional stakeholder feedback, the following enhancements are being added:

- An expanded list of qualifying courses and degree programs;
- Elimination of the six-month waiting period to access the tuition remission benefit;
- Addition of a 25% tuition discount for spouses and dependents on qualifying post-baccalaureate programs;
- An increase in the undergraduate discount and other discounts for eligible employees working less than 1,560 hours annually. This includes:
 - 100% tuition remission for the employee.

- \$25,000 discount for a spouse/dependent enrolled full-time in qualifying undergraduate programs
- 25% tuition discount for spouse/dependents for part-time qualified undergraduate programs and qualifying post-baccalaureate programs.

The expanded tuition remission and discount benefits to Creighton University's Total Rewards program are in response to the recent survey feedback and aligned with Creighton's objectives to attract and retain outstanding faculty and staff.

- Located outside of the Brandeis dining entrance, Father Sully's is a temporary store with lunch menu items, including made-to-order sub-sandwiches, sliced pizza, soup, salads and sides. It is named after the Rev. Jeff Sullivan, SJ, student retreat coordinator.

- Closed Saturday and Sunday

McGloin Market

- **Monday to Thursday**
 - 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- **Friday**
 - 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Closed Saturday and Sunday
- Located on the bottom floor of McGloin Hall in the old Java Jay location, the McGloin Market is a convenience store with lunch menu items, including Godfather's pizza, wings, breadsticks and beverage. Signs will be located outside.

Purchasing 2023-2024 Parking Permits

Creighton employees in Omaha can purchase surface-lot parking permits for the 2023-2024 academic year through [JayPark](#), **beginning Monday, June 26**. Limited garage parking spaces are available to employees. Registration for the garage parking lottery opened June 5 through JayPark and closes at 11:59 p.m. CDT on Friday, June 16.

There will again be a tiered pricing structure, decals will be mailed directly to homes and enforcement will begin on Aug. 1, 2023. [Read more information here.](#)

Summer Employee Parking

The Department of Public Safety and Parking Services offers Omaha campus employees (with any current year permit) the option to park in the 20th and 24th street garages through Monday, July 31.

Employee vehicles without garage permits must be out of the

garages after the listed date. Vehicles without a garage permit that remain in the garage after the listed date will be subject to citation. Those employees with a perimeter decal can move to employee surface lots as the shuttles are not running.

Over the summer, employees will only park in either the garages or employee surface lots with valid permits.

Parking Lot Closure: Lot 68, Werner Center

Parking Lot 68, east of the construction of the new CL and Rachel Werner Center for Health Sciences Education, is currently closed for renovation work. The work is scheduled to be completed by Aug. 1.

Vehicles can continue to access parking lots 58 and 48 from Cuming Street or Burt Street.
