The visitors, with an unbroken string of victories to their credit, are determined to win a decisive victory and clinch their claim to the championship of the big Eastern colleges. The Pennsylvania students, coaches and players, on the other hand, are hoping that the Red and Blue team will repeat the history of the two other elevens and retrieve an otherwise disastrous season by winning.
