## CU Partnership to Hold Eighth Annual Youth Health Extravaganza

A Youth Health Extravaganza, sponsored by the Creighton University Medical Center Partnership In Health, will offer free back-to-school physicals to underserved and economically challenged families on Saturday, Aug. 19. The eighth annual event will be held 8 a.m.-noon at the Omaha Public Schools' Teacher Administrative Center (TAC), 3215 Cuming St. Close to 500 children take part in this free health services program. The event will offer to youth: free school physical and dental exams; screenings for asthma, blood pressure, hearing, height/weight, hemoglobin, lead and vision; roundtable discussions on such timely topics as nutrition/obesity, asthma, and tobacco prevention/smoking cessation; activities for young children such as clowns, face painting and other family activities; and bilingual documents and interpreters (Spanish and Sudanese). Parents or guardians must accompany students to the event and bring copies of the children's immunization records with them.
