

Report From The DePorres Club

At the regular Monday night meeting the DePorres Club heard a report of police brutality. They saw a bloody shirt which reportedly was blooded by a beating given by several policemen.

The reported victim brought the information to the club. It was voted to contact his lawyer and the police department.

Two cases were reported of Negro men being arrested when going through an area where white women had reported being attacked.

The club voted to thoroughly investigate and take action next week.

A possible case of a Jim Crow pay roll was reported. The complainant said, white employees were paid on Friday and Negro employees paid on Saturday. The club voted to send the manager a letter of inquiry.

The major activity of the club will be to continue working for a equal job opportunities ordinance. Certainly a group has no right to call itself an intelligent supporter of the fight against racial discrimination unless they get active NOW.

This ordinance will be presented no later than February.

It was decided to picket Reeds Ice Cream Saturday night if the weather permits.

Members were asked to take the names of the five or six people who are being seen buying Reed's Ice Cream, so a personal contact can be made with them.
