Just the same old routine with people sick & suffering & dying all around, 75 of them. Three passed away recently & yesterday I gave the last Sacraments to the most pathetic & deformed cripple we have ever had here. He will not last much longer. Hope Wim survives his retreat & gets a change at the end of it. Yesterday's Life had some fine pictures of some of my classmates and old army friends: Eisenhower, Spaatz & Royce. One of my old students from the "U" of Detroit days is coming to see me tomorrow. We will take a good drive together & have a good visit. Emmett says he is building a new plant in Calif. & may be by soon. Love. John
