1. System Administrator Update – Mark Andrews

-CuFind is up and running and is current through March 12. There was an interruption in automatic transfer of records. However, it should be running every night. Mark made a gap file that covered Dec-Mar.

-Working on making MARC holdings records visible in CUFind.

-Ran authorities for January and February. There are 5358 records.

-Mark will start testing 3.4 as soon as CuFind is done. Everyone else can start testing around the first of April. The upgrade/reindexing will need to be coordinated with the AUP, which we get back in the middle of July.

-More of the library sites that were running on windows had issues with the upgrade.

-246: if you browse as a title, it's not skipping over subfield i. It is working correctly for the video format. The rest of the formats will need to be tweaked before the reindexing.

4. Library updates

a. Law: Nebraska briefs are being put into the CDR. 2500 briefs have been scanned so far.

b. HSL: Bryan is getting estimates from publishers for how much it will cost to allow access to electronic resources for students in the Medical School's Phoenix program

The building is being rewired and should be finished by early August. The wireless is also being upgraded.

All three libraries bought the 2011 Springer e-books. Around 830 records were loaded.

c. Reinert: All 3 libraries are looking at the discovery system.

The library has purchased films on demand. MARC records have not been loaded into the catalog yet because they're waiting to see how they look in CuFind. Sally suggested changing using FILMS ON DEMAND for the call number.

Reinert's items have been moved out of the Goodwin Tucker Building. The journals were recycled.

Reference is downsizing. Most of the big sets have been recycled. An open classroom may go into that area.

Reinert is finally getting a new roof. Work is currently being done on the north end of the building.
