Creighton University announced today it has hired Donald C. Bishop from Cornell University as the associate vice-president for enrollment management. For the past six years Bishop has served as the associate dean of students and enrollment management at the School of Hotel Administration at Cornell. His duties will begin at Creighton in mid-August. Bishop, who received his undergraduate and graduate degrees in economics from the University of Notre Dame, was the first undergraduate hired directly after graduation as an admissions officer in 1977. When he left Notre Dame in 1985, he was the associate director of admissions. From Notre Dame, Bishop went to Ohio Wesleyan University where he served as the dean of enrollment management from 1985 to 1994.

Fundraiser for Pediatric AIDS Research: World League Wrestling title matches are being

held at the South Sokol Hall on Saturday, July 13, at 8 p.m. All proceeds benefit Creighton University Medical Center's pediatric AIDS research efforts. Wrestling matches included in the line up are the WLW heavyweight title, world tag team title and WLW ladies title. Cooperation with Water-Use Reductions: Creighton University is aware of the Metropolitan Utilities District request for voluntary water-use reduction and is doing its part in the program. Facilities Management has implemented a plan that has each area of campus watered on alternating days. Some parts of campus will be watered on odd numbered days and some parts will be watered on even numbered days. The amount of time spent watering any particular irrigation zone will be reduced from an amount that now equates to about three-fourths of an inch of rain a week. Each irrigation zone will operate twice during the time period of 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., where now the zone operates only once after midnight. This will cause less evaporation but may be an inconvenience for some as sidewalks get over sprayed because irrigation is started earlier to get the twice a day application. Watering of the trees and flowers with the water truck will continue on a daily basis because the method is extremely conservative. The big black water rings around trees will continue to be used as well as a hose from a faucet or from a fire hydrant to do selective watering. The fountains will continue to operate because they recycle the water and only require replenishment to compensate for evaporation. The fountains may need to be turned off when the water conservation program is no longer voluntary.
