

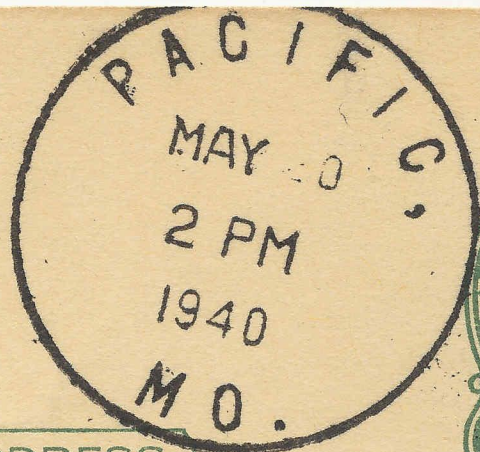
May 20, 1940.
